1. INTRODUCTION

We will use qualitative and quantitative indicators to make both an assessment of the quality of the project and of the achievement of the objectives we have set.

The **qualitative assessment** will evaluate the achievement of the objectives and the quality of the final outcomes (research paper, handbooks, syllabus, SI projects, pilot studies, etc) and it will be led by the Romanian and Turkish universities. They will also be in charge of the creation of the necessary evaluation tools.

The **quantitative assessment** will be led by the Spanish and Italian teams and it will evaluate:

- the coordination of the project
- the implementation of the project,
- the dissemination and the impact
- the sustainability
- and the satisfaction of the stakeholders

In the transnational meetings, a full revision of the project progress, an evaluation of the results so far and a possible risk assessment will be done in order to ensure the correct execution of the project and the expected efficiency

After all the mobilities, an evaluation of the activities and trainings will be done. To do so, we will use online surveys to assess the students' and teachers' progress and satisfaction, and we will monitor the quality of the products and the activities in order to correct any possible shortcomings.

The Coordinators team will be responsible for this process and for all the possible adjustments needed.

2. QUALITATIVE ASSESSMENT

The Romanian and Turkish team are in charge of this supervision. They are also going to design and implement the necessary tools to evaluate. The results of this evaluation will be gathered in two assessment reports that will be delivered before the intermediate report and the final report. Nevertheless, there will be regular briefings about the ongoing results in all the mobilities in case any deviation might occur.

a. The Project Objectives

We are going to assess the qualitative achievement of the project objectives by developing specific tools of measurement such as:

- Rubrics to measure the quality of the SI projects and the PBL projects
- interviews with the teachers involved in the pilot and the partner schools
- direct observation of the implementation of the projects
- check lists to ensure that all the necessary steps are being taken

We believe that the previous monitoring in pilot schools of all project topics and procedures will ensure the correct implementation within the project and will greatly contribute to the achievement and the quality of all our objectives.
